Lieutenant General Bruno Buratti was born in Rome in 1961. He is married and has two daughters. He graduated from high school and was admitted to the Guardia di Finanza Academy in 1981.

During his career, he was appointed to several relevant positions, such as:

- Interregional Commander of North-Eastern Italy (October, 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018 – May, 30<sup>th</sup> 2022);
- Project Officer of the Guardia di Finanza General Headquarters since June, 1<sup>st</sup> 2022;
- Interregional Commander of Central Italy (November, 14<sup>th</sup> 2022 – June, 6<sup>th</sup> 2023);
- Inspector General for Educational and High-Training Institutes of the Guardia di Finanza since November, 7<sup>th</sup> 2023.

He holds a degree in:

He achieved a University Master's degree in 2005/2006 in "Business Tax Law" at the University "L. Bocconi" in Milan.

Taught and continues to teach legal, economic and technical-professional subjects at several Universities, Educational and High-Training Institutes of the Corps and other interagency institutes.

He has published essays and articles on legal and professional topics in specialized magazines and is co-author of numerous professional publications.

He has participated, as a speaker, in a variety of conferences and seminars on legal, economic and technical-professional issues, with particular regard to anti-money laundering legislation.

He is a connoisseur of Military History, a member of the Military History's Italian School, the Italian Institute of Castles and the Deputation of Local History for the Venices, as well as an Academic Councillor of the Veneto Athenaeum.

He is a member of the Scientific Committee of the Association of Professional Italian Numismatists, the Archconfraternity "Scuola Grande di San Rocco" in Venice and an honorary member of the Venetian Heritage Foundation ONLUS.

He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Moral Institution "Museo Storico della Guardia di Finanza" and chairman of the Assistance Fund for Guardia di Finanza Personnel.

As project manager of the Guardia di Finanza for the organization and coordination of initiatives aimed at the creation of new museum centers and the overall enhancement of the historical and architectural heritage of the Corps, he has participated in numerous forums on issues relating to the recovery and enhancement of state property of historical interest. He is currently engaged in the Forte Aurelia Antica recovery valorisation project.

He is the promoter and co-author of historical publications and author of essays of historical and cultural interest.

He was the promoter and coordinator, in collaboration with the *Fondazione Musei Civici di Venezia*, of the Committee for the celebrations of the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of Francesco Morosini, established in 2019.

He was a member of the official Committee for the celebrations of the 1600<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the foundation of Venice, set up in 2021.

He was an honorary member of the "Committee for anniversaries of national interest" within the "Mission structure for the enhancement of national anniversaries and the participatory dimension of the new generations", established by Prime Ministerial Decree of April, 13<sup>th</sup> 2021.

He is awarded the Cross of *Commendatore* of the Order "Al Merito della Repubblica Italiana".
