Om Kakani serves as the ICHIP in São Paulo, Brazil. He is on detail from the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Ohio where he serves as an Assistant U.S. Attorney (AUSA). As an AUSA since 2013, he served as the District's Computer Hacking, Intellectual Property coordinating attorney, and National Security Cyber Specialist. During his time as an AUSA, Om was involved in the successful indictment and extradition of three Romanian nationals, whose botnet infected over 350,000 computers and was responsible for approximately \$40 million in fraud in the United States. In addition to his work with the U.S. Department of Justice, Om has taught cyber security law courses at Cleveland State University and Kent State University.



Prior to joining the U.S. Department of Justice, Om was an Assistant District Attorney in Staten Island, New York, where he was the lead prosecutor on over 30 jury trials. He graduated from Emory University where he was an Emory Merit Scholar and Senior Class Marshal before receiving his J.D. cum laude from the University of Michigan.
