Suffolk County District Attorney Raymond A. Tierney is a career prosecutor, having served more than 29 years as a prosecutor at both the state and federal levels. Elected on November 2, 2021, he is committed to enforcing the law in an ethical and accountable manner to protect the citizens of Suffolk County. DA Tierney is experienced in managing and conducting investigations and prosecutions of all manner of criminal cases, including but not limited to arsons, child pornography, crimes against intellectual property rights, domestic violence, homicides, kidnappings, organized crime, political corruption, gang violence and violent sexual assaults.

Since assuming office, DA Tierney has assembled an elite leadership team of career prosecutors to oversee the office's 250+ assistant district attorneys. Under Tierney's direction, the office is now taking a more proactive role in combating crime from organized retail theft to the fentanyl overdose crisis. In addition to reestablishing the office's Homicide Bureau, Tierney formed the Violent Criminal Enterprise Bureau as a comprehensive investigative and litigation solution to the epidemic of gun and gang violence in Suffolk County.

Current cases of interest include the trial conviction of David Ostrove for stealing over \$8.4 million dollars from the Schechter School of Long Island while serving as the Chief Financial and Technology Officer; the Murder convictions of Valerie Owusu and Emmanuel Addae for the beating death of Owusu's 5-year-old son, King Owusu; the recent indictments of 31 alleged Bloodhound Brim gang members following a long-term investigation that covered 34 separate incidents, including eighteen shootings, three armed robberies and three long-term conspiracies; and the prosecution of Rex Heuermann for the Gilgo Beach murders of Melissa Barthelemy, Amber Costello, Megan Waterman and Maureen Brainard-Barnes.
